





In a bid to equip the youth of Tamil Nadu with industry-relevant skills, Don Bosco Arts and Science College has embarked on a significant journey through the Naan Mudhalvan – a skill development initiative launched by the Government of Tamil Nadu. This transformative program aims to provide dynamic and career-oriented training to college students, bridging the gap between education and industry demands. Naan Mudhalvan, meaning "I am the Leader," aspires to create a brighter future for the youth of Tamil Nadu. It focuses on offering students comprehensive information about courses and industry-specific skill offerings, empowering them to select and pursue their chosen career paths successfully.

The core objectives of the Naan Mudhalvan scheme are to identify potential training providers and address current industry gaps by imparting essential skill training. The program strives to ensure that students not only receive training but also secure employment opportunities matching their skill sets.

The Course Coordinators have been diligently assigned in each department, facilitating a seamless learning experience. Students have been mapped to their respective faculty members through the Naan Mudhalvan portal, ensuring efficient guidance under the supervision of the Principal and Vice-Principal. As per directions of the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation, the institution facilitated Phase 1 and Phase 2 Faculty Development Programs for selected courses. These programs, conducted physically over a week in January, under the aegis of Cambridge, Ingage, NSE Academy, and Acenovation. Faculty members were equipped with the necessary skills to effectively train students in their respective courses.

"CHANGING YOUR PERSPECTIVE CHANGES YOUR EXPERIENCE"

It was a beautiful evening at the Lalit Kala Akademi where I, along with my students in the B.Sc and M.Sc Visual Communication programs, witnessed a completely "Unseen Perspective" of around 560 government school students from 11 districts of Tamil Nadu. About 800 photographs that spoke volumes about the mindset, lifestyle, culture, and social space of these students adorned the walls of Lalit Kala Akademi. As we passed through each photograph, we saw the young, bright faces of these students beaming with happiness as they showcased the fruits of their year-long workshop in which they had participated.

As part of the Arts Lab Project, introduced by the School Education Department of Tamil Nadu, these government school students from classes 9 to 12 underwent a year-long training program in photography under the guidance of the renowned photojournalist Mr. Palani Kumar, with 11 trainers, one allocated for each district. Mr. Palani, in his speech during the panel discussion, mentioned that the exhibition was more about their stories than the photographs themselves.

Stories? Yes, stories of the everyday mundane lives of compounders, trash collectors, sanitation workers, watchmen, and people working in mills, factories, and plantations were photographed and documented. While it's a usual norm for photographs of these sorts to evoke a sense of pity, these photographs captured by the young ones brought out feelings of pride, respect, and a sense of hope for a better tomorrow. And how did they manage to bring out this feeling? "Beauty lies in the eyes of the beholder."

As I stood amidst the photo exhibition, this singular line echoed relentlessly in my mind, encapsulating the profound impact of the visual narratives before me. As individuals enjoying life's luxuries, we often view trash collectors and sanitation workers with pity, yet from the perspective of these children, these individuals were nothing short of real heroes. Boomika, a Class 11 student from the Coimbatore District Government Model School, documented the misty mornings at the tea estates capturing beauty and hardship through her phone camera. She said, "When I looked around, I realized that while most parents sweat to earn a living, my parents shed blood to eke out a living."

Another student, Seshathri, from Class 12 at the Thiruvallur Model School, who aspires to study journalism, documented his mother Mala donning her work attire—a green uniform and a pair of sturdy gloves. She empties trash bins and scrubs away the stains of urban life. In the close-up shots, we see the telltale signs of her labor—the calloused hands and tired eyes. He said, "After my father died two years ago, my mom has been solely taking care of us. She wakes up at 5 am, sells milk, and then goes for her sanitation duties. It has a lot of health risks. She gets skin rashes and faces other difficulties but still continues with the job."

Cinematographer PC Sreeram, honored as the Chief Guest, remarked, "As I observe the photos of these students, I witness a remarkable growth that knows no bounds. These images exude a profound brightness and optimism, transporting viewers to another realm." Director Pa Ranjith extended his congratulations to the students and Mr. Palani Kumar. He remarked, "There's often discrimination against children attending government schools. Many hold preconceived notions that life in a slum equates to darkness. However, I personally experienced vibrant life growing up in a slum. My school instilled in me immense confidence."

"Unseen Perspectives" was truly a wonderful experience that not only captured the vivid lives of these children but also served as an avenue to challenge societal perspectives. Students who witnessed the exhibition were in awe and felt inspired. They also had a brief interaction with Mr. Palani Kumar and expressed their wishes to him and the young talents

This comprehensive approach leads to more informed and balanced decisions.




