



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR WOMEN STUDENTS

Dress Code

- 1. Girl students are expected to dress modestly. The college mandates that students wear salwar kameez, Knee length kurta's with shawl while on campus.
- 2. Wearing Shawl or Stole in the college campus, inside the classroom is mandatory.
- 3. Avoid wearing Sleeveless attire, torn jeans, cropped T shirt, night pants in the college campus.
- 4. Wearing of casual dresses like collarless T-Shirts, collared T-Shirts with images or words on them, sleeveless tops, short skirts and tight pants must be avoided.

Wearing ID Card

- 1. All girl students should wear her identity card while on campus.
- 2. Tampering with/misuse of ID Cards or bus passes will result in withdrawal of these facilities.
- 3. Loss of ID card should be reported to the college authorities.

Entertaining outsiders

Entertaining friends from other colleges is not allowed inside the campus especially during the break hours and after the college hours.

Possession of Drugs and Smoking

- Unauthorized possession or use of harmful chemicals and banned drugs. Girls found with guilty of substance abuse or in possession of drugs will be suspended/dismissed from the College
- 2. Smoking within the College campus is forbidden





Discrimination

Engaging in harassment or discrimination on the basis of race, religion, gender, disability will be punished.

Anti - Ragging

Ragging in any form is prohibited. Any such violation should be brought to the notice of Anti-Ragging Committee. Stringent action will be taken against defaulters as per UGC guidelines, copy of which is given to students and parents

Prevention of Sexual Harassment

Sexual misconduct will be met with a strict disciplinary action.

Usage of Social Media and Mobile Phone

- Girls may not post negative statements about the College/ faculty/staff/other students on social media websites. Violation of this will result in severe sanctions, including dismissal from the College.
- 2. Girls are not permitted to do recording of either audio or video of the lectures delivered in class rooms, actions of other students, faculty or staff without prior permission.
- 3. Mobile phones should be in silent mode while on the college campus.

Disorderly Conduct of Girls

 Students should not use obscene language or engage in violent behaviour that would affect personal safety of any individuals. If in case the she damages the individual property of the individual/college property she should pay for the damage, loss.





The various forms of Misconduct that Girl Students should refrain from, include:

- a) Organizing meetings and processions without permission from the Institution.
- b) Accepting membership of religious or terrorist groups banned by the Institution and/or
- by the Government of India

c) Unauthorized possession, carrying or use of any weapon, ammunition, explosives or potential weapons, fireworks contrary to law or policy.

d) Protests/strikes on campus by students are banned. Students participating in them are liable to be suspended/dismissed from the College

e) Misdemeanor and /or exhibiting disruptive attitude at the time of Students' body elections or during any activity of the college.

f) Any kind of misconduct/ misbehaviour inside / outside the campus (in public places, buses, trains etc) or detection of foot board travel, blocking the traffic, unruly behaviour in busses / trains or any kind of annoyance to the public will also result in the immediate withdrawal / permanent cancellation of all travel concessions and scholarships.

Permission to be Obtained

- a. Students are not permitted to participate in live/photographic modelling, fashion shows, stage shows or any TV programmes without prior written permission from the principal.
- Letter from parents is mandatory while attending seminar, workshops, conference, intercollegiate events in other colleges. The letter must be submitted to the concerned HOD two days before.
