

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates who have completed the Higher Secondary Examination or any other course recognized by the University of Madras as equivalent to it are eligible to apply for the Undergraduate course.

Application for admission to B.Com General / B.Com Corporate Secretaryship / B.C.A / B.Sc Visual Communication & M.Sc Visual Communication can be obtained from the college office.

The admission procedure for the Under Graduate programme shall begin 3 days after the publication of the Higher Scecondary Examination Results.

An Entrance Test will be conducted for Viscom (UG and PG) students, followed by a personal interview.

Selected candidates must pay the prescribed fees and submit the original certificates at the College Office.


